FAQs



Here are some frequently asked questions and answers to assist you in the admissions process.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR ADMITTING SIBLINGS OF CURRENT COVENANT STUDENTS?

Sibling applicants are prioritized. They should apply for the next school year by February 1st. Though admission is not guaranteed solely based on sibling status, we aim to serve as many children from a family as possible. Once a family completes the admissions process with one child, they don't need to repeat the family interview. Sibling applications and placement tests are typically in January, with decisions made prior to the continuous enrollment period.

IS AGREEMENT WITH COVENANT'S FOUNDATIONAL BELIEFS MANDATORY?

Yes, parents must sincerely agree with and live by our Mission, Statements on Faith, and other essential documents. As a covenantal discipleship school, our partnership works best when aligned in core beliefs and values, supporting the spiritual development initiated at home and church.

CAN STUDENTS JOIN MID-YEAR?

Yes, students can join after the academic year starts, adhering to the standard admissions process. Such transitions can be challenging, so each case is assessed individually.

HOW CAN I AVAIL OF TUITION ASSISTANCE?

Begin by discussing Tuition Assistance with our Admissions Team during your application process.

HOW DOES COVENANT MANAGE WAITING LISTS?

We maintain an active applicant pool instead of a waitlist. If no openings match your child's grade but they fit our school model, their application remains active for potential future openings.

This application can be reactivated in the next admissions season, usually starting in November.

DOES PREK ATTENDANCE GUARANTEE PROGRESSION TO KINDERGARTEN?

No. All prospective Kindergarten students undergo a Kindergarten Readiness Assessment. This aids both parents and the administration in making the best decision for the child's educational journey.

CAN I OBSERVE A CLASS IN SESSION?

To maximize instructional time, class observations are not allowed. However, you can schedule a campus tour to experience our environment and community firsthand.

DOES COVENANT OFFER SPECIAL EDUCATION?

Generally, Covenant cannot provide specialized assistance for severe learning disabilities. In specific cases, we might offer additional support services for particular learning differences, usually at an extra cost.

WHY IS THE COVENANT ADMISSIONS PROCESS EXTENSIVE?

Each step in our admissions process is designed to ensure both the school and the family understand and are aligned in our shared mission. This rigorous approach helps us collaboratively train children spiritually and academically.



WHAT IS A FAMILY INTERVIEW?

After application submission, families are invited for an interview. This session, usually 45 minutes, is a mutual opportunity for understanding and aligning with the school's philosophies. Students in grades 7-12 and both parents must attend.

WHY ARE ACADEMIC ASSESSMENTS MANDATORY?

These assessments gauge a student's readiness for our rigorous curriculum, ensuring they thrive and aren't discouraged.

ARE OTHER STANDARDIZED TESTS USED FOR ELIGIBILITY?

While other evaluations can be considered, our assessment method also evaluates a student's work ethic, attitude, and approach to challenges.

WHAT IF MY CHILD UNDERPERFORMS IN THE ASSESSMENT?

Performance challenges are addressed individually. Options might include retesting, recommending a prior grade for enrollment, or suggesting specific areas of focus before potential future enrollment.
